Feminism Beyond Institutions: Sudanese Women's Agency in Times of War

Mawa Mohamed is a research fellow at the Chair of Global South and Gender Studies in the Department of Political Science at Goethe University Frankfurt. She holds a Ph.D. in Sociology and Social Research from the Università degli Studi di Milano-Bicocca and is specialised in post-war recovery studies, gender dynamics, and international relations.

This talk explores how Sudanese women respond to war beyond formal political institutions. Focusing on women's solidarity, survival strategies, and everyday forms of resistance, it examines how women sustain families and communities during conflict and displacement. Drawing on feminist political economy and women's lived experiences in Sudan, the lecture reflects on care, resilience, and social support as important forms of political agency in times of war.
