You will be able to completely work remotely. Work meetings will take place via zoom.

- Completed bachelor's degree in a social or information science subject (sociology, political science, psychology, administrative science, business informatics, data science, NLP or similar).
- Current (second or postgraduate) studies in a social or information science subject (sociology, political science, psychology, administrative science, business informatics, data science, or similar).
- Interest in political sociology, LLMs, data annotation or computational social sciences.
- Basic understanding of data annotation, data preparation and data use.
- Basic knowledge of Python is an advantage.
- Very good knowledge of one of the target languages: Italian, Turkish, German, English (at least B2 level).
- Good knowledge of German or English for communication within the project.
- Enrolled in any German or non-German university (outside Germany).

The contract term is flexible (limit of 80 hours per month). The salary is about 16 EUR per hour. Please note that you may be required to pay local taxes and social security taxes in your country of residence.
